**1) Georgia Safe Driving Superhero Scholarship - \$2,500 - 1 Award (Deadline: March 31, 2020)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently a Georgia high school senior or an undergraduate in college/university.
- B) Be attending post-secondary institution in the Fall of 2020.

**2) SP High School Scholarship - \$10,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2020)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school student planning to attend college in September 2020.
- B) Answer the Essay question on the sponsors website.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a Women between the ages of 16-19.

B) Have experience in local government, student government, or workplace leadership (paid or unpaid).

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

B) Be planning a career in computer science, information technology, management information systems, or another closely related field.

**6) Community Bankers Association of Georgia Scholarship - \$1,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: April 3, 2020)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a Georgia high school senior.

B) Be entering a Georgia university, college, or technical institute (if program is two or more years) in the fall semester of 2020.

- B) Be majoring in real estate or a real estate-related field.
